**Choo Choo Junction** is a hands-on activity room at the Great Overland Station. The room is geared to bring imagination to life and to educate on trains and safety.



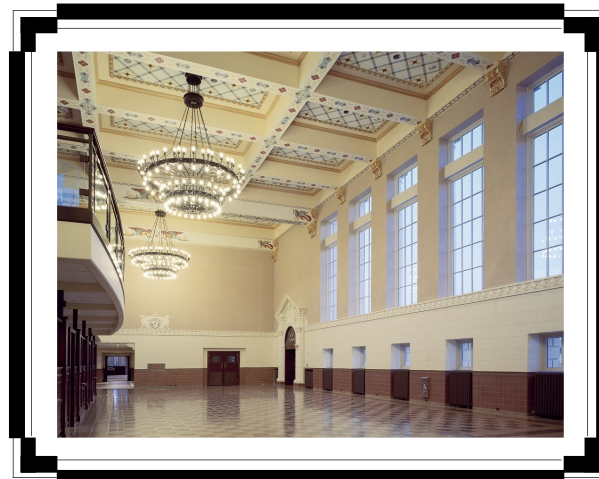
